ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Avon Lake Charter Section 20, the Council of the Municipality has the power to fix the salary of the Mayor, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE,
STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That the salary of the Mayor of the City of Avon Lake, Ohio, be and the same is hereby established at the rate of \$98,000 per year, payable bi-weekly, effective January 1, 2016.

Section No. 2: That the benefits provided for, and as amended from time to time, in §260.03 Cod. Ord. Sick Leave, §260.06(e) Cod. Ord. Holidays, §260.09 Cod. Ord. Life Insurance, §260.095 Cod. Ord. Dental and Eye Care Insurance, §260.08 Cod. Ord. Health Insurance, §260.18 Cod. Ord. Bereavement Leave, §260.22 Cod. Ord. Jury Duty, PERS, shall also be paid and/or provided to the Mayor, effective January 1, 2016.

Section No. 3: That the Mayor shall receive an annual vacation of two normal work weeks with pay as of January 1, 2016. Further, the Mayor shall receive five personal holidays.

Section No. 4: That the salary and benefits to be paid and provided to the Mayor as set forth herein are the total compensation to be so paid and provided for the performance of the duties of the Mayor's office as established by applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the general supervision of the Police Department, Fire Department, and all other departments created from time to time having to do with the preservation of the safety of persons and property within the Municipality, until such latter duty is otherwise proved for by Council as provided in the Avon Lake Charter.

Section No. 5: That any and all ordinances or resolutions which are inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be repealed as of January 1, 2016.

Section No. 6: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 7: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of adopting legislation to increase the compensation for the office of Mayor by the deadline imposed by Section 20 of the Avon Lake City Charter. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
