## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR LEGAL COUNSEL AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 59 of the Avon Lake City Charter, entitled Competitive Bidding, authorizes the expenditure of funds without public bidding for "personal services" as defined in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Administration and Council desire to continue to retain the personal services of Todd S. Davis, as legal counsel for the Brownfield redevelopment and environmental aspects of the West End Redevelopment, including the former NRG Power Plant.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section No. 1:</u> That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Todd S. Davis, Esq. of Cleveland, Ohio for the purpose of retaining personal, professional services for Brownfield redevelopment in the west end of the City.

Section No. 2: That said agreement shall state among its terms that the cost of said personal, professional services shall not exceed \$35,000.00. Upon receipt of an itemized billing, in conformance with the guidelines and scope of work as set forth in said agreement, to the satisfaction of the Economic Development Director, the Director of Finance is hereby directed to deliver to Todd S. Davis, Esq. the warrant of this City in the amount due and payable and to cause said warrant to be paid.

Section No. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of providing legal counsel and environmental consulting services for Brownfield redevelopment in the west end of the City, thus for the health, safety, and welfare of the public. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
