

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE LORAIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF UPDATED COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH, RECORD MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, AND MOBILE COMPUTING PLATFORM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Avon Lake desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Lorain County Board of Commissioners for Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Record Management System (RMS), and Mobile Computing Platform (MCP); and

WHEREAS, Lorain County has entered into an agreement with Tyler Technologies for the installation of updated Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Record Management System (RMS), Mobile Computing Platform (MCP) and all software and hardware for use by the County 911 system; and

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Board of Commissioners agree to share in the annual maintenance costs for the software and servers used by County 9-1-1 for Tyler Technologies software.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Lorain County Board of Commissioners (Exhibit A).

Section No. 2: That the Memorandum of Understanding with the Lorain County Board of Commissioners dated February 25, 2015 to participate in the New World Systems Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Records Management System (RMS), and Mobile Computing Platform (MCP) is hereby null and void.

Section No. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of fulfilling the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding, thus for the health, safety, and welfare of the public. Therefore,

this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
