AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT A \$580,000 GRANT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, DIVISION OF WILDLIFE FOR A FISH CLEANING STATION AT MILLER ROAD PARK, REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 21-110, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Avon Lake in receipt of a \$580,000 grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Wildlife for the construction of a fish cleaning station and other improvements at Miller Road Park; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a Grant Agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Division of Wildlife.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section No. 1:</u> This City Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City to accept the grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Wildlife and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Grant Agreement to accept the funds.

Section No. 2: That Ordinance No. 21-110 is hereby repealed.

<u>Section No. 3:</u> This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

<u>Section No. 4</u>: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
