

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A JOB DESCRIPTION FOR THE POSITION OF CAPTAIN IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, ESTABLISHING THE QUALIFICATIONS AND DUTIES FOR SAID POSITION, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 21-84, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been recommended by the Human Resources Committee that a revised job description for the position of Captain in the Fire Department be adopted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That the specifications, responsibilities, and duties applicable to the position of Captain in the Fire Department shall be as shown on the job description, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section No. 2: That Ordinance No. 21-84 is hereby repealed.

Section No. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to adequately staff the Fire Department and bring optimal services to the residents of Avon Lake, thus for the health, safety, and welfare of the public. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
