AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 23-19 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: Ordinance No. 23-19 is hereby amended as follows:

Section No. 4 (as amended): That Mr. Hamker shall be entitled to receive the applicable benefits provided to full-time, non-bargaining employees enumerated in Codified Ordinance Chapter 260 and a Uniform Allowance in Section 260.07(c). Upon the completion of his 90-day probation period, he will receive five personal days to be used prior to December 31, 2023.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of providing adequate staff to handle the inspection load in the Building Department to ensure that plumbing safety standards are met, thus for health, safety, and welfare of the public. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
