AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 452.03, ENTITLED PROHIBITED STANDING OR PARKING PLACES.

INTRODUCED BY: Mr. Kos

WHEREAS, the Public Safety and Health Committee and the Police Chief recommended amending Codified Ordinance Chapter 452.03; and

WHEREAS, Council coming now to consider said recommendation approves it in full.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section No. 1:</u> That Codified Ordinance Section 452.03 Prohibited Standing or Parking Places is hereby amended as follows:

No person shall stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to comply with the provisions of this Traffic Code, or while obeying the directions of a police officer or a traffic-control device, in any of the following places:

- (a) On a sidewalk, except a bicycle;
- (b) In front of a public or private driveway;
- (c) Within an intersection;
- (d) Within 10 feet of a fire hydrant;
- (e) On a crosswalk;
- (f) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
- (g) Within 30 feet of, and upon the approach to, any flashing beacon, stop sign, or trafficcontrol device;
- (h) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless a different length is indicated by a traffic-control device;
- (i) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
- (j) Within 20 feet of a driveway entrance to any fire station and, on the side of the street opposite the entrance to any fire station, within 75 feet of the entrance when it is properly posted with signs;
- (k) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
- (I) Alongside any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
- (m) Upon any bridge or elevated structure upon a highway, or within a highway tunnel;
- (n) At any place where signs prohibit stopping, standing or parking, or where the curbing is painted yellow, or at any place in excess of the maximum time limited by signs;
- (o) Within one foot of another parked vehicle;
- (p) On the roadway portion of a freeway, expressway, or thruway which is covered by any accumulation of snow or ice;

- (g) On the roadway portion of the following main thoroughfares in the City: Lake Road, Electric Boulevard, Walker Road, Miller Road, Moore Road, Avon Belden Road, Jaycox Road, and Lear Road, Webber Road, and Krebs Road;
- (r) On the paved portion of the side of the street on which fire hydrants have been installed.
- (s) No person shall stand or park a vehicle upon any tree lawn for which the owner of the tree lawn has obtained a pollinator planting permit.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
