A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE DISPOSAL OF AN INOPERABLE VEHICLE AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO SCRAP AN INOPERABLE VEHICLE AND TRANSFER THE VEHICLE TITLES TO REED'S SALVAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15(c), the City is authorized to dispose of personal property that is unfit for use; and

WHEREAS, Avon Lake Regional Water delivered an inoperable 2009 Ford F250 vehicle to Reed's Salvage of Grafton, Ohio in 2022 and has identified a 2008 GMC Savanna vehicle that is inoperable and unfit for use; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to confirm, adopt, and ratify the disposal of the 2009 Ford F250 vehicle and authorize the Director of Finance to scrap the 2008 GMC Savanna and transfer the vehicle titles to Reed's Salvage of Grafton, Ohio.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section No. 1:</u> That Council hereby confirms, adopts, and ratifies the disposal of a 2009 Ford Model 2S F250, VIN No. 1FTNF20559EA72307 to Reed's Salvage of Grafton, Ohio in 2022.

<u>Section No. 2:</u> That Council hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to dispose of a 2008 GMC Model SA2 Savanna G2500, VIN No. 1GTGG25C781124877 to Reed's Salvage of Grafton, Ohio.

<u>Section No. 3:</u> That the Director of Finance is directed to transfer the vehicle titles of said inoperable vehicles to Reed's Salvage of Grafton, Ohio.

Section No. 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 5: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of disposing of inoperable City property no longer needed for public use and to bring additional revenue into the City, thus for public welfare. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
