AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ENGINEERING CONSULTANT SERVICES FROM CHAGRIN VALLEY ENGINEERING, LTD. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council authorized a professional services contract with Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. for Municipal Engineering Consulting Services by Ordinance No. 22-69; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. to provide additional engineering consultant services separate and apart from said contract pertaining to plans review of subdivisions or private commercial developments; MS4 permit coordination with the Ohio EPA for stormwater compliance; sidewalk program implementation; and surveying miscellaneous projects to support the Walker Road project design, the resolution of any private property issues, and other engineering projects.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section No. 1:</u> That Chagrin Valley Engineering Ltd. be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to provide additional engineering consultant services on behalf of the City of Avon Lake for plans review fees of \$10,000.00, permit coordination fees of \$5,000.00, sidewalk program implementation fees of \$5,000.00, and surveying fees of \$7,500.00.

<u>Section No. 2:</u> That the necessary expenses for said services be paid upon approval voucher submitted therefore, in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00.

Section No. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section No. 4:</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to make immediate provisions for the performance of municipal engineering services, thus for the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Avon Lake. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
