

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME PERSONNEL ROSTER
OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Human Resources Committee have recommended that the authorized full-time personnel roster of the Fire Department should be changed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That the authorized personnel of the Fire Department of the City of Avon Lake shall be, and it is hereby established as follows:

Chief of Fire Department	1
Assistant Chief of Fire Department	1
Captain serving as Fire Marshall	1
Captain of Fire Department	3
Lieutenant of Fire Department	3
Firefighter/Paramedic	27
Administrative Assistant	1

Section No. 2: That this Ordinance shall supersede all other formerly passed legislation relative to the roster of authorized full-time personnel of the Fire Department.

Section No. 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of providing adequate personnel for the Fire Department to effectively perform their duties, thus for the public safety, health, and welfare. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
