AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES ON BEHALF OF THE CITY WITH BRAMHALL ENGINEERING & SURVEYING CO. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Avon Lake entered into an agreement for personal services with Bramhall Engineering & Surveying Co. of Avon, Ohio for Municipal Engineering Consulting Services expiring December 31, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That upon delivery of the municipal engineering services rendered to the full satisfaction of the Finance Director, he is hereby authorized to deliver to Bramhall Engineering & Surveying Co., of Avon, Ohio the warrant of this City in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 and to cause said warrant to be paid.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section No. 3:</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to make immediate provisions for the performance of municipal engineering services, thus for the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Avon Lake. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
