

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH  
GEAUGA HIGHWAY CO. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been found that a change order to the contract with Geauga Highway Co. of Hiram, Ohio is needed for the 2023 Asphalt Walking and Bike Path Program; and

WHEREAS, the change order will be to add extra stone on the walking and bike paths that were found without a stone base; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and Finance Committee have reviewed said expenditure and recommend that Council approve said change order for an amount not to exceed \$55,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That the \$55,000 change order to the contract with Geauga Highway Co. of Hiram, Ohio is hereby approved and accepted.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of completing the repaving of the walking path in Resatar Park and the bike path at Westview Elementary before asphalt plants close for the season, thus for the public health, safety, and welfare. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
