

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR THE LEAR ROAD BUMP PROJECT  
AT THE RAILROAD TRACKS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has received an invoice for work performed by Underground Utilities, Inc., of Monroeville, Ohio, according to the terms of the contract, on the Lear Road Bump Project at the railroad tracks, in the amount of \$90,692.12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: Council hereby authorizes payment for the work performed by Underground Utilities, Inc., of Monroeville, Ohio, according to the terms of the contract, for an amount not to exceed \$90,692.12, with \$70,535.22 being the City's portion and \$20,156.90 being Avon Lake Regional Water's portion.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of fulfilling the City's contractual obligations timely, thus for the public health, safety, and welfare. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
