

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AVON LAKE MUNICIPAL COURT TO SELL AN OBSOLETE COMPUTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Avon Lake Municipal Court ("Court") is in possession of a computer (HP laptop) which is unneeded, obsolete, or unfit for municipal purposes, including for use in the Court offices; and

WHEREAS, the computer has an estimated value of less than one thousand dollars; and

WHEREAS, Section 721.15(A) of the Ohio Revised Code permits the officer having supervision or management of unneeded or obsolete property with an estimated value of less than one thousand dollars to sell such property as said officer deems appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That Council hereby authorizes the Clerk of the Avon Lake Municipal Court to sell the unneeded and obsolete computer at such sum and to such persons as the Clerk deems appropriate.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section No. 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
