## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 22-115 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section No. 1</u>: That Ordinance No. 22-115 is hereby amended, effective January 1, 2025, as follows:

<u>Section No. 1:</u> That appointment of Christofer McKay to the position of Captain in the Fire Department, be and it is hereby approved and confirmed, subject to the Civil Service Rules and the Administrative Code provisions of the Codified Ordinances, effective August 1, 2022.

<u>Section No. 2:</u> That the duties and responsibilities to be performed and undertaken by the Captain in the Fire Department are shown in the job description for said position adopted by Ordinance No. 22-113.

<u>Section No. 3:</u> That in addition to Mr. McKay's duties as Captain, he will serve as the City's Fire Marshal, effective August 1, 2022.

<u>Section No. 4:</u> That City Council has and does hereby fix a bi-weekly salary of \$3,841.86 for the Captain position plus a 3.5% stipend of the Captain's rate to serve as the Fire Marshal, as allocated by the Director of Finance.

Section No. 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section No. 3</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of providing the Fire Department with adequate personnel for the efficient operation of the Court, thus for the preservation of the public's health, safety, and welfare.
