AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LABOR AGREEMENT WITH THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE LODGE #25/AVON LAKE DIVISION FOR THE POLICE OFFICERS AND DETECTIVES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a labor agreement has been reached by the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #25/Avon Lake Division for the Police Officers and Detectives and the City of Avon Lake.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a labor agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #25/Avon Lake Division for the Police Officers and Detectives for compensation and other employment of municipal employees for the period from January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2027, in accordance with the language set forth in the agreement which is on file with the City.

<u>Section No. 2</u>: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section No. 3</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate need to provide compensation and other employment provisions as agreed upon in labor negotiations so that personnel may be available to the City, thus for the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Avon Lake. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
