This survey was available online and in hard copy, starting May 22, 2023 and was open until June 9, 2023. During that time, 525 were completed online, and 9 were completed with pen or pencil and then, those hard copy surveys were entered individually, as if they were done online. 






Ability to upgrade or downgrade your cart size, based on changing needs of your home. ⁵²⁸ responses









Weekly bulk pickup. 519 responses




Bulk pickup only on demand 516 responses


Yard waste collection through the end of December. 530 responses




Proper disposal of yard waste (not placed in landfill). 528 responses











Larger recycling cart option for those with more recycling volume. 525 responses




Reduction of recycling pickup to once per month. 517 responses




Clear label on recycling cart listing acceptable items. 526 responses




Tagging of carts that violate recycling requirements. 522 responses




Recycling bin/dumpster available at the City Service Center.




E-cycling opportunities (recycling of electronics and their components). 526 responses


Ability to place service on hold while on vacation, with a reduction in fee. 522 responses





Cart Size Options:

- a smaller trash cart would be nice

- Allowing a lower fee for a smaller bin is a good idea
- Anymore recycling should be larger than regular for many people
- Because we compost and recycle so much, we only have one small garbage bag a week so a smaller garbage bin is
 essential
- Bigger cans are needed
- Bigger please
- Bigger recycling bins, ability to upgrade
- Cart size is less important than yard waste pick up
- common sense tells you to have a bigger recycling container over the trash container to encourage recycling at all times! That is not the case now. makes zero sense. I have way more recycling then i do trash every week, but i end up putting that recycling in the trash defeating the purpose of recycling

- I'm not sure how a smaller cart reduces collection fees. If it does, great but otherwise a smaller cart size would just be for convenience of smaller garage space, etc.
- I'd love smaller trash / recycling cart options that cost less + fit more comfortably in my garage when my car is in there.
- If a larger size is available than the currently offered size and little to no extra cost, that would be great. We are a
 family of 3 and our trash is always at max capacity.
- If I had a smaller family, I would want smaller cart options.
- If the biggest cart size (what we have now) would go up in price due to others needing smaller carts and paying less, I
 wouldn't want it. Larger price shouldn't go up just to accommodate needing a smaller size for the company to make
 more money.
- If you make more trash, you should pay more money. I do not want to suppliment someone else's waste.
- If you could offer ways on how to reduce the amount of trash a household uses, then offering different sizes could be an incentive- especially if the fee changes per container size
- It would be nice to be able to have a second set.

- We are a family of 4 and the trash cans are currently too small for us. Yes we do recycle.
- We are seniors on a fixed budget and have very little trash. Please give smaller cart option @ lesser fee.
- We do not need a smaller size but agree this option should be available
- We get the largest size and it works
- We moved here last year and weren't aware of container size options.
- We should be able to have bulk pickup whenever we need it
- We use the medium size for both carts. It has worked very well for our usage.
- Why does cart size matter? Even low volume residents can use a larger cart since you're picking up mechanically.
- Would like the option of a bigger recycling cart. We routinely fill our recycling bin and not our trash bin.
- You should pay for what you use, no more and no less

Bulk Pickup Options:

- Abuse of bulk by residential who run businesses
- Again, I do not want to pay for other people's wastefullness! This should be an add on option only.
- Allowance for the 1 month allowance needs to be more generous.
- As is in current contract
- Bay just switched to weekly bulk.
- Being able to schedule bulk pick-up helps me.
- Bulk pick up should be more limited and arranged on demand. This would also discourage the trash pickers which cause traffic issues and safety concerns.
- Bulk pick up should be unlimited
- Bulk pickup included on demand. If I dont have a bulk pickup for 3 months but need two bulk pickups 2 weeks in a row. It should be available because I have not had them for consecutive months in a row
- Bulk pickup now is a pain and the definitions of "bulk" and "large" are not well defined on the Kimble site and literature
- Bulk pickup only on demand is absolutely ridiculous.
- Bulk pickup should be allowed at least once a week. Unfortunately, we live in America where everything is bigger. That
 means more waste bigger boxes etc. I shouldn't have to call to an unresponsive service to get bulk pickup.
- Bulk pickup should be available as a weekly service included in the refuse contract.
- Bulk pickup should included in the contract weekly
- Bulk required; minimum of monthly
- Contractors should be excluded from bulk pickup.
- Could be done monthly on a set day
- Current company randomly charges for bulk pickups whether they happen or not
- Currently sofas of unlimited weight are fine to be included in bulk pick up but a lighter weight concrete patio bench is
 not. It is almost as if you play by the rules and call you are told no, but if you put whatever out without calling things
 would get taken away.

- I am happy with having the option to pay an extra but standard fee for weekly pick up as we do now. Although we have
 had issues with company not actually picking up the bulk every now and then.

- I believe that bulk pickup is essential, and I'm good with it only being once a month, but I wish that the trash company
 would pick up bigger items easier. For example, I would love to leave a big item and they would be able to dispose of
 it.
- I don't need bulk pickup. Why do I have to pay for other people's excess.
- I don't like needing to plan it ahead. Sometimes we don't know ahead of time.
- I like being able to choose my own, once a month, for bulk pick up. If I have to pay, how much? will rate go down if bulk is an extra service vs included with standard contract. I'm for anything to reduce the cost.
- I like knowing I can use bulk pickup when needed
- I like the current option
- I like the flexibility of being able to have bulk picked up on any day
- I preferred the previous contact where there was a set bull pick-up day. On numerous occasions I had to reach out to Kimble multiple times to get one bulk pickup scheduled
- I rarely use bulk pickup and would prefer not to subsidize other people. Not sure how to answer the above questions to reflect this.
- I think it would be reasonable to offer a contract that give the 'option' for a variety of services that the average low usage homeowner could benefit from through the high usage homeowner could sign up to benefit from.
- I think once per month is adequate
- I was told I had to email them prior to putting out my bulk trash. This was after they left it 3 weeks in a row.
- I wish it was weekly and didn't involve multiple phone calls
- I would like to have bulk pickup under contract unless it reduced the price significantly
- I would rather have a set number of bulk pickups rather than once a month. Some months I have the need to use twice but most months I don't use it.
- I'm ok with a "charged per pickup" method as long as it doesn't equate to costing more than if it were included in the contract.
- If I put it out, Take it away!
- If I'm paying for this service, I believe I should be able to put anything I want to the curb, any time I need to.
