- Over 29,000 accident-free manhours thru November 30th, 2022
- Recently conducted Demolition Update Meeting with AVLFD Capt. MacKay
- All workers are required to attend Site Specific Safety Training •
- ALERG Safety Committee meets bi-weekly
- ALERG, ARC & Trifecta all have fulltime on-site safety representatives
- Task specific Work Plans are reviewed & approved by site team prior to start of new work
- All vendors have a Hazardous Communication Program and conduct morning safety tailgate meetings
- Over 35 on-site workers are First Aid & CPR trained
- Fire Extinguisher Training recently completed for plant ٠ personnel

- Coal Yard clean up is in progress
- Coal Yard Run off pond & ditches have been cleaned
- Total materials removed from site to date:
 - 477.5 Tons of Fly Ash
 - 31.48 Tons of Carbon
 - 18.77 Tons of Hydrated Lime
 - 105,206 Gallons of Plant Chemicals and Waste Oils









Abatement



- Abatement of Boilers 9 & 10 & Turbine 9 are in progress ٠
- 7 EPA site visits to date with no violations ٠
- Materials Removed From Site: ٠
 - 422.52 Tons of asbestos friable materials 0
 - 182.32 Tons of asbestos non-friable materials Ο
 - 127.2 Tons of contaminated dust 0











Demolition

Completed Demolition

- Demolition of coal yard structures has been completed
- Conveyor over Lake Road has been removed
- CEI 345 KV Service to building has been disconnected
- Lake Erie plant intake and discharge have been closed off
- Demolition of Precipitator #9 to start January 2023
- Removal of oils & Universal Waste continues















- Coal yard ponds have been cleaned
- 2 Coal runoff emergency retainment ponds have been cleaned
- Coal yard storm water basin design is in progress
- Coal yard runoff ditch has been cleaned
- Materials Removed From Site:
 - Over 36,000 Tons of coal have been removed from site



Rail Removal Completed



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- 5 miles of track have been removed and are being recycled
- 15 truckloads of spikes & plates have been recycled
- 15,000 rail ties currently being removed from site
- 60% + of rail ties recycled for landscaping & fence post use.
- Omaha Track is demobilized the site.
