Native Plants to Be Planted in Tree Lawn			

- Please attach a sketch of the tree lawn with your application, including location and approximate size of plants, sprinklers, mailbox, water shut-off, manholes, etc.
- If installing sprinklers, a permit from the Building Department and a Right-of-Way permit will also need to be obtained.
- Prior to planting, approval from the resident's home owner association (HOA) will need to be secured, if applicable.
- The City is not responsible for any plantings in the right-of-way. Site will be restored to grass if any future work is necessary.
- Regular inspections will be conducted by the City. Sites that are found to be in non-compliance will be notified.
