- Prior to planting, approval from the resident's home owner association (HOA) will need to be secured, if applicable.
- The City is not responsible for any plantings in the right-of-way. Site will be restored to grass if any future work is necessary.
- Regular inspections will be conducted by the City. Sites that are found to be in non-compliance will be notified.

*Aquilegia canadensis* - red columbine  
*Asclepias hirtella* - green milkweed  
*Coreopsis* spp. - tickseeds  
*Erigeron* spp. - daisy fleabanes  
*Erythronium americanum* - yellow trout lily  
*Eupatorium purpureum* - sweet scented joe-pye-weed  
*Gentiana alba* - plain gentian  
*Helenium autumnale* - sneezewood  
*Helianthus hirsutus* - hairy sunflower  
*Heuchera americana* - alumroot  
*Iris virginica* var. *shrevei* - Shreve's iris  
*Liatris spicata* - blazing star  
*Lobelia cardinalis* - cardinal flower  
*Mertensia virginica* - Virginia bluebells  
*Monarda punctata* - spotted beebalm  
*Packera plattensis* - prairie groundsel  
*Penstemon pallidus* - pale beardtongue  
*Phlox bifida* - cleft phlox  
*Polemonium reptans* - Jacob's ladder  
*Rudbeckia laciniata* - cutleaf coneflower  
*Solidago speciosa* - showy goldenrod  
*Symphotrichum ericoides* - health aster  
*Tiarella cordifolia* - foamflower  
*Tradescantia virginiana* - spiderworts  
*Trillium flexipes* - nodding wake robin
